

Dalit Caspi-Schachner is Head of Cybersecurity Strategy at Bank Hapoalim, the first position of its kind in the Israeli banking system. She leads Bank HaPoalim's efforts to construct coherent strategies, policies, procedures and capacity planning for the effective reduction of cyber risk. Dalit is also in charge of collaboration with Bank

HaPoalim's cyber partners, and oversees regulatory compliance in the evolving field of cybersecurity.

Dalit recently retired from the IDF at the rank of Lt. Colonel. Throughout her service, Dalit combined various disciplines in her assignments, including electrical engineering, operations research and strategic planning. She also led various research teams in the IDF and in the Israeli Defense Industries.

In her last few years of IDF service, Dalit worked in the Planning Directorate, focusing on the relations between strategic considerations and military capacity planning. Through her position, she influenced the Order of Battle (ORBAT) and resource allocation decisions made by the IDF and the Ministry of Defense (MOD). She also advised national (non-military) organizations, including the Ministry of Defense, the National Emergency Management Authority and the Public Security Ministry, and occasionally briefed Knesset members and ministers on strategic issues.

Dalit holds a B.Sc. and a M.Sc. in Electrical Engineering from the Technion, and a Master's in Public Administration from the Harvard Kennedy School.
