



**Don Hunt** is a postdoctoral research fellow in the Department of Criminal Justice and Criminology at Georgia State University in Atlanta, Georgia, USA. A former head of fraud and

cybercrime analytics for one of the world's largest digital payments processors, Hunt directs his primary research toward understanding the changing landscape of crime as society moves forward into cyber space and continues to adopt advanced payment technologies. He is specifically interested in analytical strategies that may offer policy and prevention strategies for computer-based crime; particularly with phishing, spear phishing, and ransomware attacks. Hunt has authored articles in the *Journal of Quantitative Criminology*, *Homicide Studies* and *Criminal Justice Review*. In 2015 he was awarded the prestigious Bureau of Justice Statistics Graduate Fellowship, which came with a \$95,000 grant for his research in crime and digital payments.
