



**Prof. Jacques de Werra, Vice-Rector, University of Geneva**

Jacques de Werra was born in 1970 and earned a doctorate at the University of Lausanne in 1997. He also holds a Master's degree in Law (LLM) from Columbia University and was admitted to the bar in both Geneva and New York. He teaches, conducts research, publishes, and lectures in the areas of intellectual property, information technology and communication, and contract law. He launched a summer school dedicated to Internet law (Internet I@w summer school) and directs the summer school on intellectual property which has been organized in cooperation with WIPO since 2011. He became a professor at the University of Geneva in 2005, and was named Vice-Rector of the University of Geneva in 2015. He is in charge of the University's digital strategy and of the technology transfer activities.
