

Prof. Fabiana Di Porto is Associate Professor of Economic Law and Innovation at the University of Salento (Lecce) and LUISS University (Rome), Italy.

She is Co-director of the annual journal "Concorrenza e Mercato. Competition, Regulation, Consumer Welfare, IP", Giuffrè ed., Milan (since 2011) and member of the Executive Board of the international Academic Society for Competition Law – ASCOLA (since 2017).

As component of the National Behavioral Unit she advises the Italian Presidency of Council of Ministries for the application of behavioral insights to the analysis of (central) administrative action (since 2017). In 2017 she has been appointed member of the board of Braincircle Italy.

Her most recent research interests include digitalization and big data, on which she has published a book ("Disclosure Regulation. The Challenges of Cognitive Sciences and Big Data", 2017) and several articles and has been audited as national expert before the Berec, the European Commission and the Italian Authority for the protection of minors (2018).
