



**Yehonatan Abramson** is a Lecturer (Assistant Professor) in Department of International Relations at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.

He holds a Ph.D. from Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, MD. The thematic focus of Dr. Abramson's research is identity politics across borders. Specific subjects include International Relations theory, nationalism and religion, migration and diaspora politics, and critical security studies.

Abramson's research has been published in peer-reviewed journals, such as the *European Journal of International Relations*, *Political Geography* and the *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*. One of his current projects studies the symbolic foreign policy dimensions of cyber incidents across the Middle East using primary media sources in Arabic.
